Chaplaincy Australia—Update on Victorian Bushfires



August 7, 2009 marked the six month anniversary of the Black Saturday bushfires that devastated Victoria and impacted so many lives. CA has Chaplains continuing to *'support people thru life'* on behalf of our ACC Churches and we'll be here for the long haul. It could be 12 months, it could be two years, but we'll be there supporting the community through every step of the process.

Our work has been (and continues to be) on the radar screens of all levels of Government – Local, State and Federal. This community response is the biggest ever undertaken by the ACC and CA in Australia and it has galvanised courage into our Fellowship of what can be done to show Australians the power of the Gospel message in action.

In the town of Flowerdale this caring message has been responded to with this somewhat staggering request, **'When can you start a Church in our town?'** Much more prayers and financial support is needed moving forward, but we are thankful of your support enabling this huge response to happen.



Kids Hope has finally started. We are beginning with four mentors, while we wait for more parents to consider the program.

I met my little boy today. He was very excited to see me, and I think the fact that I was only there for him made him feel very special.

When I pulled out a sheet about himself that we were going to look at, he gasped at the soccer sticker I'd stuck on the sheet to make it look interesting and he said, "You've got a soccer sticker on it. How did you know I love soccer?"

George made some observations regarding these volunteers when he was in Zambia. They certainly need our financial and prayerful support.

- *** Our volunteers are living under the bread line and we are their only hope (in their view) . It was amazing how they understood when I explained to them the challenges we face to help them and I just wonder how much we understood their worlds?
- *** Bicycles are viewed as an amazing tool for both doing their work better and faster but also to earn some extra income e.g. when they go to visit children they can also use their bicycles as a form of transport to earn some money.
- *** In Makululu and Agape HBC out of 60 volunteers 75% of the volunteers had orphans in their homes to care for!!!
- *** One of the biggest challenges they have is to get these orphans into school. i.e. uniforms / school fees. Feeding them is a huge burden they carry.



What is BOOST Tour?

BOOST Tour is an outreach event into Europe over the summer holidays. It will have a carnival type atmosphere with a multi-media gospel presentation designed for lasting impact on the communities and churches visited. It exists to come alongside the local church and give them a BOOST in reaching their community. BOOST Tour 2010 will be touring Slovakia 30 July – 16 August.

What will BOOST Tour do?

We will be reaching out to an estimated 10,000 plus people during the 16 day event. We believe many lives will be transformed and added to the local church in Slovakia as a direct result of BOOST Tour. It will also cultivate links between church and society whilst BOOSTing the church's profile throughout their community.
