Sometimes we come across stories that are sad, and a reality check for the values we live life by. We can be constantly challenged by what we understand true love to look like and the sacrifice true love is. It cost God and His Son, Jesus dearly to save us from the penalty of our sins. It was a huge sacrifice on their part, and sometimes we need to ask how much we appreciate their love for us. This little story is rather challenging and sobering for us.

"Fulfilled Dreams"

There was a blind girl who hated herself because she was blind. She hated everyone, except her loving boyfriend. He was always there for her. She told her boyfriend, "If I could only see the world, I will marry you."

One day, someone donated a pair of eyes to her. She was so excited. When the bandages came off, she was able to see everything, including her boyfriend.

He asked her, "Now that you can see the world, will you marry me?"

The girl looked at her boyfriend and saw that he was blind. The sight of his closed eyelids shocked her. She hadn't expected that. The thought of looking at them the rest of her life and the sacrifice she would have to make to live with someone who was blind led her to refuse to marry him.

Her boyfriend left in tears and days later wrote a note to her saying: "Take good care of your eyes, my dear, for before they were yours, they were mine."

How easily we can forget the love of others when our circumstances change!

Only a very few remember what life was like before, and who was always by their side in the most painful situations.
